From a humanitarian point of view rooted in love of neighbour, our activities have been developed through social cooperation partnerships with local institutions such as hospitals, prisons and churches.




ASSOCIATION





CHILDREN'S MEAL PROJECT

In 2013, the Children's Meal Project began timidly in a church on the outskirts of Luanda. The project is being developed in co-operation with the church as part of a social partnership, and is aimed at helping children in Luanda's peripheral communities with a high poverty rate.



Within this vision, our mission with the Church consists of humanitarian support, which is offered in co-operation with the Church's social sector, with which we have made a commitment to donate bread, milk and juice every Sunday to the children of the community integrated into the Church, thus enabling them to have a glass of milk and bread every Sunday before the start of religious activities.



The initiative for the project stems from the fact that there are many families living in difficult conditions on the outskirts of Luanda. Due to the various difficulties they face on a daily basis, many are forced to frequently turn to the Church for help.







During these years, the effects of our small co-operation have been beneficial for the children of the communities on the social humanitarian side. Due to the increase in social difficulties, the number of children tends to grow considerably, with the project currently benefiting around 20,000 children from 30 centres in outlying communities.

We would love to continue to show solidarity with these children, but we need your help, because due to the difficult financial situation we are experiencing as a result of the country's social and economic reality, we are finding it difficult to continue to sustain the project. We therefore appeal for solidarity from people of good faith who would like to make a small but valuable contribution to this project, through a donation that can be periodic, so that we can continue to make these children happy.





HOSPITAL MEALS PROJECT

The Hospital Meals Project began in 2019, shortly after the start of Covid-19 in Angola.

Our cooperation is implemented through an existing Social Cooperation Protocol with the Haemodialysis Centre - PLURIBUS AFRICA of the Américo Boa Vida Hospital, Social Assistance sector.

This consists of an indefinite social cooperation agreement in which we make a social commitment to donate snacks every week to around 300 patients undergoing haemodialysis treatment at that hospital. At Christmas time, we make a special snack kit to celebrate family day together. Due to the difficult social situation, many patients are abandoned by their families during the treatment process, so the weekly snack becomes an important help. With your donation, we'll be able to buy milk, juice, bread, yoghurt, fruit and other basic necessities for the neediest patients.





Through this humble gesture, the aim of the protocol is to show solidarity with the patients in order to alleviate the suffering of the most vulnerable. The snack is distributed after treatment with the aim of preventing patients from having an empty stomach when they return home, due to the various medications they have to take throughout the day.

This gesture has been an asset for the patients who, in addition to their illness, face various difficult situations. However, due to the difficult financial situation we are experiencing after the long period of the pandemic, we are appealing for solidarity from people of good faith, who would like to make a small but valuable contribution to this project, through a donation that can be periodic, in order to help us continue to help patients in need.

By donating you will help us to sustain the project, increase life expectancy and alleviate the suffering of our neighbours.







PRISON MEALS PROJECT

Nothing much is needed to make someone happy, to alleviate the inner suffering of those who find themselves in that condition for one reason or another. With a small gesture of love, we can change a person's inner condition and offer a smile to those who thought they could no longer smile.

Testimonies from the inmates, as well as from the institution's management, show that over the years the effects of our small co-operation have been beneficial on the social humanitarian side.





Under a co-operation agreement with the prison services, in order to show our affection for the inmates and their small children, this project began in 2016, with the aim of providing daily bread every day of the week for breakfast for the inmates and their small children, as well as other food items.



During the Christmas season, we celebrate a special lunch with them or offer them Christmas kits to celebrate Christmas, making them feel like family, thus conveying our affection for the children in particular.

But regrettably, due to the difficult financial situation we are experiencing after a long period of pandemic, we are appealing for solidarity from people of good faith who would like to make a small but valuable contribution to this project, through a donation, which can be periodic, in order to help us sustain the project, thus demonstrating your and our love for our neighbours.

By making a donation, we will be able to buy milk, juice, bread, yoghurt, biscuits, toys and nappies for the children.











MISSIONARY PROJECT



The activities of the Missionaries consist mainly of proclaiming the word of God, often in remote areas. This fundamental mission is accompanied by humanitarian actions of solidarity in favour of the most fragile and needy.

It is within this principle that our cooperation with the missionaries began in 2017, with the aim of supporting them during their field missions in remote areas by donating six motorbikes to help them travel from one community to another in their efforts to proclaim the word of God and provide humanitarian aid, bringing medicines and basic foodstuffs to sick and elderly people without assistance.





It will be possible for us to continue developing our projects, saving lives and giving hope to those in needs with your help.
